

CANADA: ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR BAIE DE LAMEQUE, NEW BRUNSWICK TO ADDRESS NUTRIENT ACCUMULATION AND DISPERSION



Land & Sea Environmental Consultants Ltd./OCL Group in association with Groupe Roy Consultants and NATECH Environmental, was retained to evaluate significant odour problems in the Town of Lameque due to shoreline accumulations of rotting sea lettuce. The assessment included evaluation of the assimilative capacity of the receiving waters and the issue of excess nutrients in the fish processing plant effluent. Recommendations were provided as to how to best address the effluent problem and long-term rehabilitation of the Baie. An environmental management plan was also prepared.

A presentation on this project was given at the "Fish Plant Effluent Symposium", held in Shippagan, New Brunswick, 27-29 February, 2003.
