

SAINT LUCIA: COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT STRATEGY - PHASE 2



The Caribbean island of St. Lucia has enjoyed considerable tourist-related development over the past 20 years, but this has had considerable impact on the environmental quality of the coastal lands and waters. As part of Phase 2 of the CZM Strategy Study,

Land & Sea Environmental Consultants Ltd./OCL Group was retained to undertake a detailed assessment of the role of Choc River and Rodney Bay watersheds in coastal pollution. Assessments included water and sediment quality of the watershed inputs and coastal receiving waters. and waste management preliminary .



Study outputs will be used by the Government to implement specific site measures and to use these measures as models for other areas of the island.
