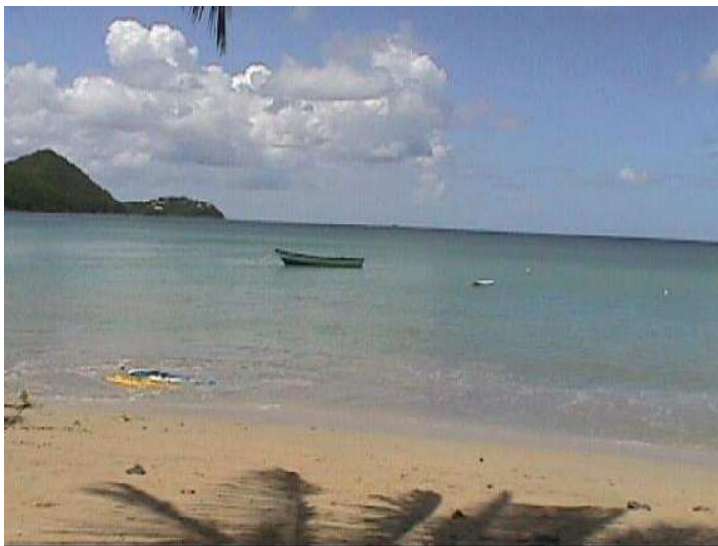




SAINT LUCIA: COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT STRATEGY - PHASE 1

However, the economic and job-creation benefits have been “counter-balanced” by the associated problems of solid and liquid waste disposal and marine pollution related to cruise liner and yacht traffic. Government concern regarding impacts on the environmental quality of the coastal lands and waters led to the a series of studies to evaluate better coastal zone management.
